

## **Testimony - James Kawalya**

I want to share some very important points from a testimony I listened to. His testimony was about 3 hours long and I know not many enjoy listening to something for so long. This testimony had such an impact on me that I felt to make notes as he went along so I can share the points for those that wont want to sit through it.

The takeaway from this that stood out for me and others who have watched this is how the enemy uses our covenants to hinder our progress. James highlights the importance of covenant prayer and how we need to have those around us interceding and praying for us, especially in positions of ministry or authority. However, I feel that this also extends to us as individuals who all have a calling on our lives and assignments to fulfil. We need to be around covenant people.

Knowing the effects of trauma on our lives, he also reiterates how important it is to get healing for our trauma as the enemy uses those parts of our soul to keep us from our full authority in the spirit. The enemy captures our soul and we need to get those parts of us back.

Some of the points of importance he spoke about are listed as follows and I have taken them as they apply in general through his testimony. There are patterns here that I have seen in my own life and in the lives of those I have ministered to. So this testimony is not only relating points that tie into ritual abuse but it can actually be seen in lives in general, how the enemy has used certain things to break down the body of Christ or to prevent assignments from being fulfilled.

- 1. Satan manipulates and controls you through pain pain from trauma or physical pain. He controls the pain you need deliverance and healing to restore your soul.
- 2. He fragments your soul and keeps you in different prisons such as bitterness, resentment, hatred, anger, unforgiveness, etc. This gives you a false identity.
- 3. You become emotionally trapped and often only know fear and no joy, which leads you to be trapped.
- 4. When we have been wounded as children, a part of us still wants to play. This part does not grow up and it affects our ability to have mature relationships with others and also to have intimacy with others.
- 5. Children who are exposed to nakedness and sexual things before they are ready are affected. Satan uses that children abused or exposed before the age of 7 it is a gate that the enemy uses to trap a soul.
- 6. When we are raised in a home without emotion, not receiving the love we need or the attention we need, we are often raised in bitterness and anger. This can cause us to not have mercy or pity for others. It is hard to show empathy.
- 7. Many have had their childhood robbed from them and they find it hard to function in the adult world. You need the Lord to help you find that part that has been trapped, rescue them, and bring them to healing.
- 8. When your will gets trapped, you will find it hard to get your will back and this also necessitates getting healing for these trapped parts.
- 9. When children are raped or sexually abused, they are initiated without realising it and they get exposed to the fruits of darkness.

- 10. Fruits of initiation are often isolation, rebellion, anger and addiction.
- 11. Initiation can be known or unknown, and there is often a guardian that is received that will be a voice in that child's life it will direct their life, but they will not know it. Often, this is also like multiple personalities, which is also a fruit of trauma or a consequence.
- 12. Sexual abuse is often used to break the will of the person. If the will was not broken in childhood, you may see repeated abuses in teens and into adulthood. This is so the will can be taken over totally.
- 13. Satan cannot destroy Satan so even though James had much power in the demonic realm, he could not save himself from the abuses he suffered at the hands of the priests because they were higher ranking. There is a satanic system that controls the world.
- 14. Emotional breakdowns due to trauma often are used to facilitate further trauma. In his case he went into a psychiatric unit where he was drugged and sedated and futher abuses took place. It was here that his abuses realised there was a part of him they could not access. A part that God protected.
- 15. They used his longing for a father to lure him back to where he would do more work for them. There are many with father wounds that will listen to men that say the right things because of the wound within him to have someone love them and protect them.
- 16. One of his assignments was to identity the men of God who were not compromised. They were to attack them, break their businesses, marriages, ministries, etc. Men who were committed to prayer. Although he speaks about men, I believe this is equally valid for women of prayer.
- 17. They would lure them into traps by fulfilling a need they had and so open the door to bring destruction.
- 18. A strong prayer ministry can totally destroy demonic altars in a territory. The people who pray for a leader in that area make it possible for them to ascend in authority in the spirit. He uses the example of Apostle John Malindi, whose words would echo for days in the spirit because of those around him who prayed for him.
- 19. The occult maps the lives of people who are a threat, their families, and those who pray for them amplify their power. The core team around a leader all speak in one voice and this would be a whole force or energy in the spirit.
- 20. When godly truth is spoken, the atmosphere will change, and the entire realm will change, and the person speaking it can become a godly principality over the nation.
- 21. The enemy will identify things that can cause people to be offended so they withdraw their part in the wall that protects the person of authority so there can be access to them.
- 22. Those in authority over you it's about the hedge around them that helps them maintain that position those who pray are the gatekeepers. They build walls around them. When the walls break, the influence and authority are brought low.
- 23. Without a wall around you, you can speak the same words but they don't carry the same power. Those around you have been assigned a responsibility to become a wall around you. Many have not fulfilled their assignments or callings because the men and women around them have left their place or they want to build their own platforms.
- 24. A small group praying can take over territory. He shares how a pastor and 20 women prayed and were covered in a realm of light.

- 25. They prayed prayers of repentance, worship, and warfare for 6 hours every day without missing. 7000 churches and pastors all over the world had been revived due to this. They were generating power to take over the realm, and if they reached their goal of praying for 3 months like this, they would stop satanic activity for 70 years they would secure the gates of the realm.
- 26. People do not understand covenant lifestyle and in the spirit it's about covenant. The only thing that gives you power is covenant. Covenant relationship empowers ministry.
- 27. If demonic spirits never work in isolation then you cannot be alone in intercession, you must be in covenant with others. Remember that the enemy is a counterfeiter and he has learned from the Father when he was in a position of authority. He copies this in his realm so we need to take heed when we see things happening in the spirit.
- 28. Enemy will use weaknesses in your life including generational patterns.
- 29. Agreement of covenant between people must not be broken. Even in Satan's kingdom, covenants are important and carry much weight. That is how he often traps us due to generational covenants that were never broken.
- 30. The moment we go into the flesh, like reacting to offence, we give a curse a place to land. An open door to shut down the things of the spirit especially if there has been unity or agreement over something.
- 31. Unhealed wounds, unresolved issues, anger, etc. deal with these things if you want to have power in the spirit.
- 32. Satan wants to bring breaches in the covenant. He wants to infiltrate what God is doing and will use people to come in and destroy unity under the guise of helping.
- 33. If you have agreed on something with others, then stay in that covenant; often, if others try to come in, it can be a ploy from the enemy to disrupt the work God has started. It breaks the covenant.
- 34. Satan also like to start with breaking our personal covenant with God interferes with our sleep, interferes with our prayer time with God through sickness or others that need our time etc. and it can cause us to pull away from the covenant. It makes us tired so we cannot pray.
- 35. Satan will also try to separate a person in authority from their core team. They may still be in covenant, but he defiles the covenant, pollutes the water and then interferes with the timing of things.
- 36. He will find various ways to bring defilement in our hearts, our bodies, and our relationships.
- 37. If God has given you an assignment, deal with your wounding, as even minor things count.
- 38. If you are going into a season of prayer time, you need to bring your family into the covenant so the enemy can not use them.
- 39. James had no father over his life to cover and protect him. You need an authority to cover you no matter how much God has called you. You need a spiritual father.
- 40. Satan will try to drive you away and isolate you from the altar away from the men and women who pray for you. He will isolate you from people who love you, pray for you and cover you.
- 41. Eventually, there is grumbling and complaining, which causes disunity.

- 42. Once the person of authority is isolated, the covenant is defiled and polluted, but there is still some authority the man of God is then incited to curse the people. Something will happen to cause you to speak a curse on those who are supposed to be protecting you.
- 43. Once the curse is spoken, then the wounded soul comes to attack the others that were part of the covenant are now also defiled. There is confusion and fighting.
- 44. Even in pain, we can get to the finish line if we are willing to repent and change our ways.
- 45. The least in God's kingdom is greater than the greatest in the kingdom of darkness.
- 46. You lose authority when you get angry it takes your power. Even in the kingdom of darkness, this is so; anger robs power.
- 47. Satan and his demons cannot fight when Jesus appears he has to go.
- 48. All exposure to Satan will bring pain and abuse to you and shame.
- 49. It's not only about deliverance but people need emotional healing.
- 50. Seek and confess find someone to share your story. Don't hide your story. Share it; the more you share, you heal. Break the silence be silent no more.

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
