



Activating the Spirit - Part 3: The Dimension of Jesus

John 10v7-9 speaks of Jesus as THE door, not a door. We all know this scripture. *“I am the door if anyone enters by Me, he will be saved and will go IN AND OUT and find pasture.*

Jesus is a portal to the heavenly realm. Otherwise, how do we go in and out? People don't get this. We have access through Jesus through our salvation to the spiritual realm and the resources available to us there.

What is pasture? It includes food, rest, and safety - these are all resources.

Sometimes we read over these verses and don't see what is hidden. There is no correlation to anything else... it says what it says. Think of Ecclesiastes 3v12 which says we have eternity in our hearts. This is a dimension we have access to. How? Jesus is eternity. We hold the Kingdom of God and therefore we are also dimensions and microcosms of the kingdom. That is why we are the temple of the Holy Spirit. As we connect with the work we do for the Kingdom or as Kingdom citizens, we are building the kingdom - we are building roads and networks in the spirit, highways for access.

I know from the work I have done with trauma and research into satanic ritual abuse that Satan has his dimensional networks. Who did he get the idea from? He counterfeited from God's kingdom template - that's where he got it from.

I feel that over the past few years, God has been giving me bits and pieces of revelation and understanding but it's all coming together as a clearer picture. It is my hope that the rest of the body of Christ will start to understand this. Just think about the authoritative power there will be on the earth through the Church if we all open up what is inside of us and allow the flow of the Spirit. We will walk in much dominion and authority.

Why is creation groaning? Creation has life but was designed to work with us because we were given dominion. But now Satan has hijacked even creation to do his bidding because we are often blind to his schemes. When those in the occult perform rituals they often use nature and the elements. They use the stars, the moon and planets. They have underwater kingdoms operated through water spirits. Their high places or rituals take place often under trees and in the forest. Trees are alive, the Word speaks about them. They harness power from nature. Why does creation allow this? Because it is man calling on nature over which we were given dominion - nature has to submit to godly design.

Part of our end-time ministry is also redeeming creation. It has been used by Satan. Creation wants to be free but is waiting for us as it says in Romans 7v21 *“because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into glorious liberty of the children of God”.*

Why does it need freedom? It has been captured as we get captured.

Verse 23 says *"For we know that the whole creation groans and labours with birth pangs until now"*.

Verse 24 says we are waiting for the redemption of our bodies and so is the earth waiting for redemption.

2 Corinthians 3v 17 says *"Now the Lord is the Spirit and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty"*.

Coming back to the access we have to dimensions, our salvation is that liberty and so if we can be free in Christ we can fully operate as spirit.

For we are from spirit - the Spirit of God - and so that is how we should live, being conduits or portals and networks for His Spirit to bring freedom!

John 3v5 says *"Jesus answered, 'Most assuredly, I say to you unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.'"*

The kingdom is not a future event. This is spoken in the present tense. Unless you are born again you cannot enter the kingdom of God. We need salvation so we can have freedom. But we need to be born again of spirit and water. We were planned by God He breathed life into us, we were first born of Him.

In my opinion, I want to present that perhaps the first event is that He planned us - we come from His Spirit. We are placed in the womb surrounded by water - the amniotic fluid that we get our sustenance from. When we are born we have to come through that water. When we choose salvation we activate His Spirit and then we get baptised to represent the Spirit, and our leaving behind of the old things. So is it all symbolic of where we came from first from Him and through Him?

John 3v13 says *"No one has ascended to heaven but He who came down from heaven, that is, the Son of Man who is in heaven."*

We see in this passage that Jesus is saying He came down from heaven but is also the Son of Man who is in heaven. All in the same breath. Jesus had access to both dimensions - if His Spirit is in us then we have access. We too can be present here and be operating in the Kingdom at the same time. When Jesus died on the cross for us, the veil was rent in the temple and we now have access to come before His throne. We need to be in this place as we spend time with Him and grow in the Spirit and strengthen our spirit in Him.

John 3v1-21 says "Jesus replied, "There was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him." Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit." Nicodemus answered and said to Him, "How can these things be?" Jesus answered and said to him, "Are you the teacher of Israel, and do not know these things? Most assuredly, I say to you, We speak what We know and testify what We have seen, and you do not receive Our witness. If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you heavenly things?"

No one has ascended to heaven but He who came down from heaven, that is, the Son of Man who is in heaven. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. He who believes in Him is not condemned, but he who does not believe is condemned already because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light because their deeds were evil. For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. But he who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God.

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
